Agricultural lands, forests, water systems, fisheries, natural/urban areas, and the global atmosphere are of immense importance for the survival of humans.

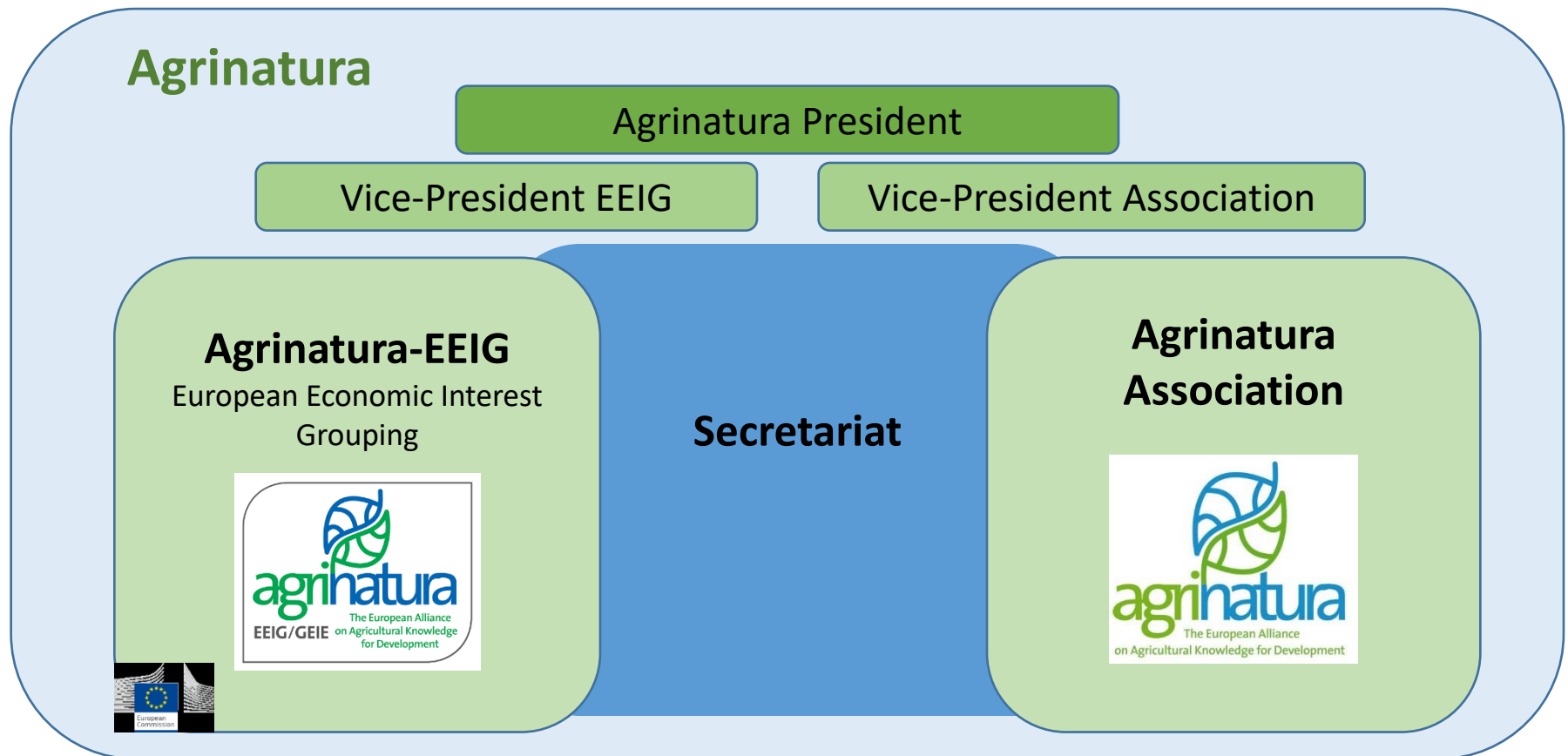
University and research institutes have the knowledge and mandate to deal with complexity rather than be satisfied with quick fixes or one topic solutions.
