## Representation at the General Assembly

The General Assembly is open to all staff and students from ICA Member Institutions, **all** are most welcome to participate in the meeting. The General Assembly is validly constituted when one third of the Member Institutions are represented. Decisions are reached by a simple majority of the votes cast. Each ICA Member Institution [who has paid the ICA membership subscription for 2016] has a right to cast one vote in the meeting. This vote will normally be cast by the ICA Representative (rector, head of college/school, or dean) of the Member Institution.

It is important that all Member Institutions are represented at the General Assembly.

If you are the ICA Representative for your institution, but you are unable to attend the General Assembly, please nominate someone else to represent you. Your vote can be given to someone else from your institution, the Representative of another Member Institution or to the ICA President by completing a Proxy Form.
